Some key events/facts in Irish History

30th January 1972, 13 demonstrators in Derry are killed by soldiers from the Parachute Regiment, known as 'Bloody Sunday'.

Montserrat in the West Indies is nicknamed the 'Emerald Isle of the Caribbean'. Some say this is due to its coastline resembling that of Ireland but this is more likely due to the fact that thousands of Irish Slaves were sent to the island in the 1600's.
