Some key July events in Irish History

- 1, 1681 Saint Oliver Plunkett hung, drawn, and guartered in England.
- 1, 1690 Battle of the Boyne.
- **3, 1918** Sinn Fein party banned by British government.
- **4, 1605** Proclamation forcing all Irish to attend services of the established church; Catholic priest ordered out of Ireland by December 10^{th.}
- **4, 1776** A cannon at Elizabethtown, N.J., under the command of Irish-born Capt. Daniel Neil, fires first shot at the British after the Declaration of Independence.
- 12, 1922 Michael Collins named head of Free State army with rank of general.
